



### All Age Groups (4-15)

**I am Robot** - This game can be split into groups of two to three, depending on volunteers and kids. One person will be the robot and the others will tell him/her where to go by saying things like, 'Move forward three steps' or 'Turn left'. Although this is a great option for ages 4-12, it is not recommended for ages 13-15.

**Bean Bag Toss** - This game will require three bean bags or objects that can be used as bean bags. Have the kids stand or sit in a circle and start with one bean bag. Have one kid say their name and toss the bean bag to another kid. That kid will say their name as well. This will continue with only one bean bag until the bean bag is back to the starting kid. Have the kids continue, but they must pass to the person they passed to in the first round, and continue to say their name. Once they are doing this fairly smoothly, add in another bean bag. Then another one, until they are working with three bean bags that are being tossed around at different times, but in the same pattern as the first round.

**Egg Race** - This game requires at least two spoons and two objects that will work as the eggs, or two actual eggs. Split the kids into two groups and mark a finish line. Put the object that works as the egg on the spoon, and have them race to the finish line while holding the spoon. They can not drop the egg, or they have to start from the beginning.
